This year my team and I are partnering with the Manly Branch of the Country Women's Association to support the CWA Disaster Relief Fund, particularly those affected by the recent fires and drought crippling some regions.

CWA Manly will hold a fundraising Christmas stall on December 7th at Manly Corso from 10am-2pm featuring a range of beautiful handmade decorations and Christmas baked goods and preserves. Direct donations can also be made at the stall on the day. Zali and her team hope to see you there.

Funds raised by the CWA go directly to those who have been adversely affected by disaster by covering household expenses such as grocery bills, vehicle maintenance, and electricity costs. Since July 2018 the CWA has distributed around \$14.5 million to help drought-stricken communities.

As part of this initiative, we are inviting all primary school students in Warringah to create their own Christmas card and write a message to rural families affected by drought.

2. Draw a picture on the front cover and write a message inside to rural families

4. The Manly branch of the CWA will send the cards to families in their regional sister branches, connecting Warringah school students with those in country NSW
