## **2022 Vinnies CEO Sleepout**



The <u>Vinnies CEO Sleepout</u> is a one-night event over one of the longest and coldest nights of the year. Each CEO Sleepout participant commits to raising a minimum amount of funds to help Vinnies provide essential services to the people who need them.

This year, the Vinnies CEO Sleepout raised a record \$9.6 million dollars nationally, with another record \$3.2 million raised in NSW alone.

## **Vinnies Buddies and Teens Days**

This program provides recreational days, from 8am - 4pm on weekends, for young people aged 5-12 (Buddies Days) and 12-16 (Teens Days), whose families are experiencing hardship and have sought assistance through Vinnies. Buddies and Teen Days also give parents and carers a little respite from caring responsibilities.

Recent Buddies Days have been generously hosted at Parramatta Marist High School (Westmead), De La Salle College (Caringbah), and Mount Saint Joseph Catholic College (Milperra).

Other fun experiences have included bowling with arcade games, Sydney Aquarium, Wild Life at Darling Harbour, with upcoming dates booked in for Putt Putt Golf, Escape Rooms and the Reptile Park.
